

Take a Seat campaign policy and Frequently Asked Questions

What do I receive when I make a gift for seat naming? Each seat naming donation is commemorated with a personalized, engraved donor plate on the seat(s) you choose when making your donation.

What is the donor plate made of? Donor plates are made of brushed stainless steel, ensuring durability throughout the life of the donor plate.

What is the donor plate size? Donor plates are 3/4" h x 3 3/8" w.

What will be on my donor plate? Each donor plate allows a maximum of 44 characters, which includes the spaces between words. There is room, if desired, for two rows of 22 characters on each donor plate. You may choose to place your own name, your own name and the name of your partner, or you may wish to recognize a relative, friend, company, etc. You may also further personalize the donor plate with phrases such as "In Memory of" or "In Honor of." All text is subject to the approval of Crown Point Venues/InConcert Sierra which reserves the right to reject any proposed text that Crown Point Venues/InConcert Sierra deems to be unacceptable. In such circumstances, the donation payment will be returned if alternate text cannot be agreed upon between the donor and Crown Point Venues/InConcert Sierra.

Where will the seat donor plate be placed? Your donor plate will be attached to the wood reveal at the top of the seat back facing the stage. Donor plates will be visible to others. You may choose any specific seat location that is not already named by another donor when you make your donation.

Will the seat with my donor plate become my seat for performances that I attend? No, this is a naming opportunity only and does not imply ownership of the seat or reserve the use of the seat for any performances. However, you may always inquire about the availability of the seat when purchasing a ticket to any event.

When will the donor plates be installed? The donor plates will be installed in time for the opening of our new facility.

Will my donor plate be permanent? No. Placement of name plates on seats will continue until the end of the useful life of the seats, which is expected to be at least 20 years, and will not continue when the seats are replaced or refurbished.

I already contributed this season. Do I qualify for a donor plate? No, this is a fundraising effort specifically related to naming seats.

Is purchasing a seat donor plate tax-deductible? Yes. Twin Cities Concert Association (dba Crown Point Venues/InConcert Sierra) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit arts organization and contributions through seat naming are tax-deductible to the full extent of the law. Federal Tax ID: 68-0164659

How can I make a seat naming donation? You may make your donation online, select your seat location and specify the text you wish to include on the donor plate, OR you may download and complete the seat naming form and mail it and your check to Crown Point Venues at P.O. Box 205, Nevada City, CA 95959.
